Gift Aid - If you give to the Church Gift Aid it!

Gift Aid is an easy way to increase the value of the donations you are currently giving to the Parish at Mass by 25%, without giving anything extra!

If you are a UK taxpayer, the scheme enables that for every pound that you give, the Parish will get back an additional 25p from the Inland Revenue.

What is required for this refund to be obtained?

- You must be a UK taxpayer and pay an amount of income tax at least equal to the amount of any refund reclaimed by the Parish on your donations;
- You must complete a Gift Aid Declaration
- Your contributions must be easily identified as coming from you

How does the system work?

You must make your contributions to the Church by Weekly Numbered Envelope (supplied by the Parish), Bankers Order or Cheque.

- Gift Aid is not a binding commitment the actual money that you donate is entirely up to you.
- You can stop at any time for any reason, in particular, if you cease to pay income tax
- Gift Aid payments are completely confidential.

Gift Aid Declaration Form

This form simply asks you to give your name, address, and consent so that all your donations can be treated as Gift Aid donations. **ONE MINUTE IS ALL IT TAKES TO COMPLETE.**

The theme this coming week is COMPASSION for refugees. This fits perfectly with our Bishops' new teaching document LOVE THE STRANGER which you can read and download at www.cbcew.org.uk. The title is from Deuteronomy "Love the stranger then, as you were strangers in the land of Egypt." Our faith teaches us that every person is made in the image of God. Every person is to be treated with dignity. Our parish is still hosting an activity for Ukrainians once a week. Sutton Deanery is still befriending the Syrian family we welcomed 5 years ago. Our bishops ask 'all the Catholic faithful to reach out the hand of friendship to migrants and refugees so that they can help us to grow in the love of God and we can together grow in fraternity and solidarity.'
