## To the Clergy, Consecrated Women and Men, and Lay Faithful of the Archdiocese of Southwark

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, brother priests and deacons, I write to you with news of great joy. Our Holy Father, Pope Leo XIV, has appointed Canon Gerard Bradley an Auxiliary Bishop for our Archdiocese of Southwark. I am so grateful to Pope Leo for his kindness in providing for the mission and care of the people and communities of our Archdiocese; and I am overjoyed – as I know you will be too – that Canon Gerard, now Bishop-Elect Gerard, will be serving in this new way among us as a Successor of the Apostles.

Bishop-Elect Gerard's Episcopal Ordination will be on Monday, 2 February 2026, the Feast of the Presentation, at St George's Cathedral, Southwark, and more details will be forthcoming in due course. The Holy Father has assigned him the Titular See of Beverley, the birthplace in Yorkshire of St John Fisher, beloved to us all in our Archdiocese as a former Catholic Bishop of Rochester.

Please keep Bishop-Elect Gerard in your prayers as he prepares for his Episcopal Ordination. This is a wonderful Christmas gift for us all.
